Organizing a bagged lunch assembly is a fun and simple way to give back to the community. From our experience, groups of five to ten people can purchase the supplies for about \$1.10 per lunch and assemble 100 lunches in under an hour.

## Lunch Suggestions

 Sandwich on whole wheat or whole grain bread (bologna, ham, or turkey with cheese)

Fresh fruit that can be refrigerated

One or two snack items (granola bar, pretzels, raisins, yogurt, string cheese, carrots, celery sticks)

Due to storage limitations, we ask that bagged lunches be delivered to our office on Wednesday afternoons or Thursday mornings.
